In the picture: A shed was destroyed by an F1 tornado a couple of miles northeast of Woodberry (Calhoun County) on 12/09/2003.

A weak tornado touched down briefly just to the northeast of the Woodberry community on Calhoun County. A mobile home was damaged when a portion of a tree fell through the roof. Three sheds were destroyed and a carport was overturned. Several dozen pine trees were uprooted or broken off along the path of the tornado. A power pole was broken as well


