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Heavy rains caused some street flooding to occur in Clinton. Several streets were closed due to high water for a brief period of time.


Izard County

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In the picture: Twenty-four hour rainfall totals as of 6 am CST on 11/18/2003 indicated that heavy to excessive rain fell across much of northern and western Arkansas. Some spots received 4 to 6 inches of rain.

Flash flooding occurred at the River Bend Park in Hardy. About 100 camping trailers and recreation vehicles were underwater. Twelve people had to be rescued from the camping trailers located at the park. No injuries were reported.

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

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
